A Healthier Future – Framework for the Prevention, Early Detection and Early Intervention of Type 2 Diabetes

The enhanced dietetic type 2 diabetes education and weight management services are now being delivered Grampian wide.

- The new Education Programme **'Control It'** will replace conversation maps to offer a 3 hour information session for patients newly diagnosed with type 2 diabetes.
- An enhanced **'Healthy Helpings'** programme is now being delivered by dieticians and is available for patients to self-refer to. Follow this link to the Healthy Weight website to find out more information click [here](#).
- The **'Counterweight Plus'** programme provides input for patients requiring advanced weight loss support.

5. Referring patients in if you have any cause for concern.


