

## NHS Grampian Dental Referral radiographs

All dental referrals must be accompanied by relevant radiographs which are properly identified and mounted.

The referring practitioner is responsible for the correct orientation and identification of any digital or conventional radiographic image sent with a referral.

When images attached to the SCI Gateway referral system and transferred, your file name, patient ID or date of exposure will not automatically be carried into NHS Grampian clinical records systems. For governance and safety reasons, it is therefore necessary for you to include patient / image details within the file itself, ie noted on or beside the image within the file you attach. Please see below for examples.

Please note that any referral which includes an unidentified or unlabelled radiograph will be returned to the referring practitioner for appropriate labelling.
