Wounds

- All non-viable tissue if currently under the care of Vascular, Plastics or Dermatology refer back in the first instance - check for historical information within SCI Store
- Surgical wounds within 6 weeks of surgery, refer back to Consultant in first instance - get permission to involve Tissue Viability if required
- Lower leg wounds should initially be assessed using the Lower Leg Ulcers Pathway to identify the most appropriate referral / specialist
- Applied Wound Management
 Assessment and Continuation Chart
 (AWM) must be completed and maintained for all wounds (excludes healing primary closed wounds)

New Pressure Ulcers

- Datix report all newly developed pressure ulcers, this is an adverse event - follow adverse event PU Duty of Candour flowchart
- All Diabetic Foot Ulcers to be referred to Specialist Podiatrist within 2 working days

• Existing Pressure Ulcers

- Ankle/Heel/Foot/Toes refer to local Podiatrist, for ongoing advice and support where required
- All other pressure ulcers refer to Tissue Viability via eclinic for ongoing advice and support where required
- Registered nurse to implement prevention and treatment at time of discovery - think SSKIN
- Surface Skin Inspection Keep Moving - Incontinence - Nutrition



• e-clinic

- Check SCI Store for any previous TV treatment recommendations
- Include a completed referral form with clinical images of the wound/s, one close up and one from a distance showing the surrounding area/s
- All **chronic** wounds within primary care, to be assessed prior to referral using the **9 Step Wound Assessement Tool 9SWAT**
