Pressure Redistributing Equipment Selection Guide



Any pressure redistributing surface does not remove the need for skin assessment and repositioning.

Powered hybrid mattresses are a combination of both foam and air and can be used as reactive mattresses (without the pump) or as active support surfaces (with the pump), e.g. Hybrid Power/ Softform Premier Active 2.

The OSKA Lateral Tilt mattress must always have pump attached and switched on, select weight and therapy mode for individual patients, see training video. When no dynamic function is required set to float.

- All patients with PVD, neuropathy, diabetes and or existing heel changes refer to CPR for feet
- Some patients/clinical areas may require specialist pressure redistributing support surfaces (e.g. Paediatrics, ICU and plus size patients). Please discuss with relevant practitioner e.g. OT, moving and handling, TVN, etc.

Equipment selection should be used in conjunction with clinical judgement and Pressure Ulcer (PU) Risk Assessment
